Look first for the very bright star Capella "cap-ELL-a". What we see as one dot is actually two pairs of stars which orbit around each other.

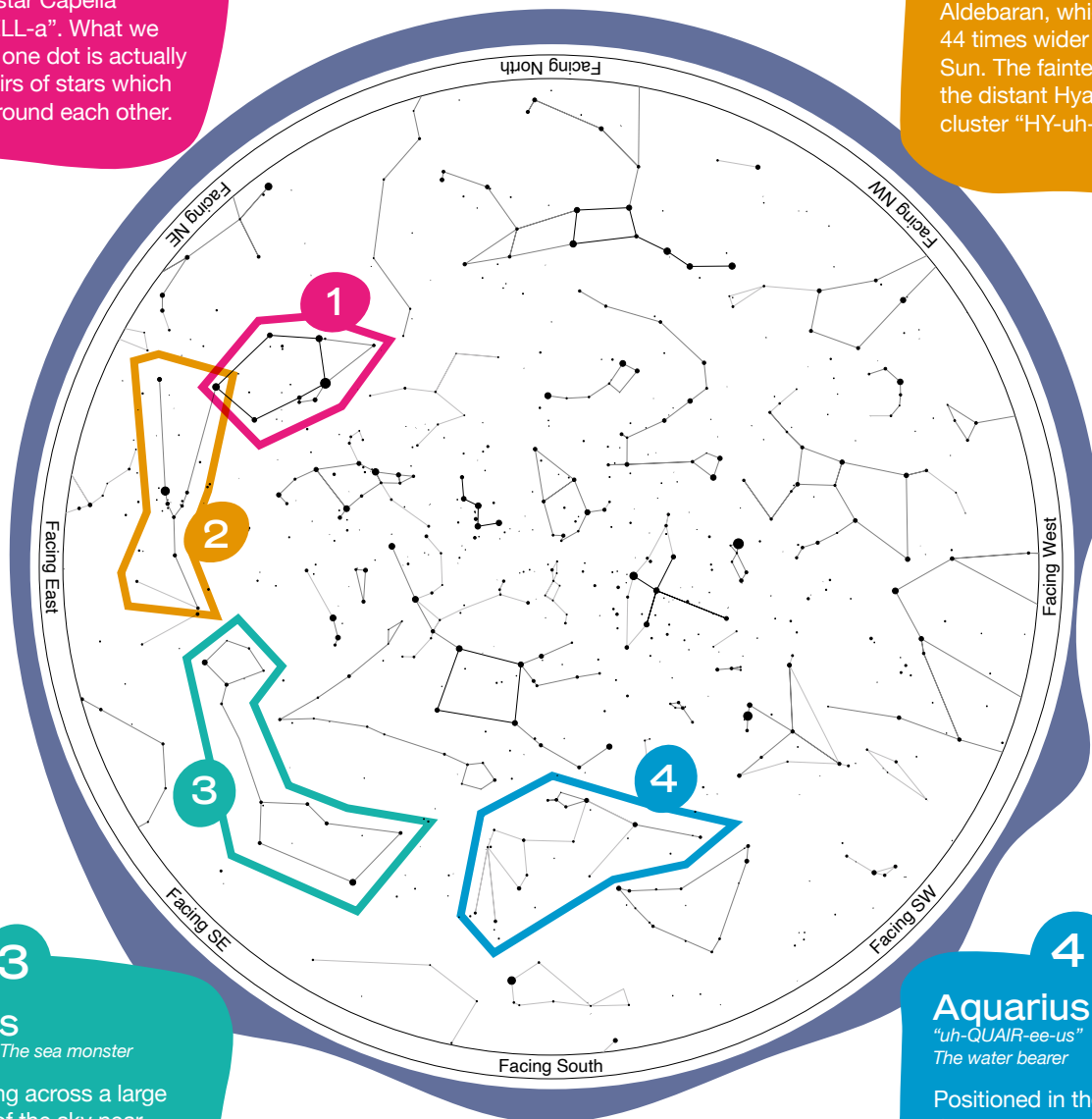

Taurus

"TOR-us"

Look for the 'V' of the bull's face with his great orange eye, the giant star Aldebaran, which is about 44 times wider than the Sun. The fainter stars are the distant Hyades star cluster "HY-uh-deez"

Stretching across a large portion of the sky near the horizon.

"uh-QUAIR-ee-us"
The water bearer

Positioned in the middle of three water constellations: Capricornus, Cetus, and Pisces.
